INVITATION FOR PROPOSALS FOR INSTALLATION OF GRID CONNECTED SOLAR ROOF TOP SPV POWER PLANTS:

Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE), Govt. of India has allocated in-principle target to NREDCAP for installation of Grid connected Solar Roof-top Power Plants as detailed below.

The in-principle approval given by MNRE, will be subject to follow conditions,

- (i) Consent letters from concerned DISCOM indicating their acceptance for extending net metering facility.
- (ii) All the plants will be installed at least as per minimum technical requirements of the "off-grid and decentralized solar applications programme" in vogue and amended from time to time.
- (iii) Only indigenously manufactured PV modules will be used in the project.
- (iv) Proper metering arrangement may be incorporated that generation data from the proposed SPV plants will be available.

Proposals in the MNRE prescribed format (may be downloaded from NREDCAP web-site) are invited for installation of Solar Rooftop SPV Power Plants from the domestic/institutions/commercial/industries to avail central financial assistance upto 30% of project cost. The eligible CFA shall be as per the norms of the MNRE in vogue and amended from time to time.

The Govt. of AP has already announced policy for net metering and the details may be downloaded from the official web site of NREDCAP, i.e www.nedcap.gov.in. The proposals in MNRE prescribed format along with consent given by the APDISCOM accepting for extending net metering facility shall be submitted to VC & MD, NREDCAP, 5-8-207/2, Pisgah Complex, Nampally, Hyderabad. Non-refundable processing fee of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) plus service tax of Rs.123.60 in case of domestic consumers (upto3 KW) and Rs. 5,000/- plus service tax of Rs 618 in case of other category consumers (upto 100 KW) by way of demand draft drawn in favour of NREDCAP payable at Hyderabad shall be paid along with the proposal.
